

Staughton Vale Triangle - Community Landcare

The triangle of land on Staughton Vale Road, next to Little River, contains significant grassy woodland vegetation including an old River Red Gum (*Eucalyptus camaldulensis*) specimen estimated by the City of Greater Geelong (CcGG) to be around 500 years old and likely to be the oldest tree in Geelong.

This small pocket of land also has remnant trees and an open area that is in need of care. The Brisbane Ranges Landcare Group, with support from the CoGG, has committed to undertaking this work.

To date, Elm suckers have been removed and a spring planting completed. This work has

enhanced the appearance of the triangle. The intent is to maintain the informal appeal for those who enjoy using it.

Casual vehicle parking will still be available. However, given the significance of the big River Red Gum and the requirements for protecting its root zone, it is requested that vehicles are parked away from this tree.

Ample space is available away from the native trees.

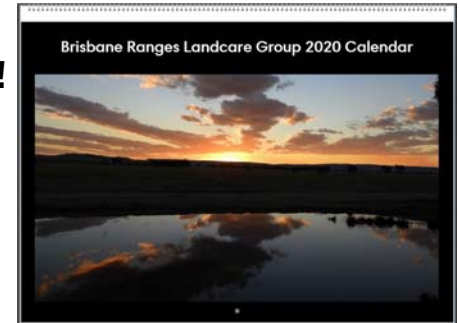

Steamed Christmas pudding

1 kg mixed fruit	250 grams dates	250 grams raisins
2 cups water	1 cup white sugar	1 cup brown sugar lightly packed
1 teaspoon salt	250 grams butter	2 teaspoons bicarbonate soda
3 eggs	2 cups plain flour	2 cups self-raising flour
2 teas cinnamon	¼ cup rum	2 teas mixed spice

Place the fruit, roughly chopped dates, raisins, water, sugars, salt and butter into a pan. Stir over low heat until butter melts, simmer mixture for 8 minutes, stirring occasionally. Remove from heat, stir in soda. Stand until mixture is completely cold. Lightly beat eggs and rum, stir into cold mixture. Add sifted flours, spice and cinnamon. Mix well. To steam: fill into well-greased 4 litre

pudding basin. Steam 6 hours; replenish with boiling water every 20 minutes. Re-steam 2 hours of day of serving.

I've made this for years and had success every time. Enjoy Christmas!

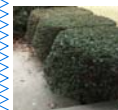
